Your personal data will be processed for:

- Documentation of the procurement procedure under the open regulations (outside the PPL) and
 its archiving, and this processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the
 controller, i.e. selection of the most advantageous bidder (art. 6, sec. 1, letter f GDPR) and is necessary
 for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is a party, or to take action at the request
 of the data subject prior to entering into a contract (art. 6, sec. 1, letter b GDPR). F
- The conclusion of a contract and its performance, and this processing is necessary for the performance of the contract to which you are a party, or to take action at your request, prior to the conclusion of the contract (art. 6, sec. 1, letter b GDPR)
- Storage and issuance of accounting documents and internal reporting, and this processing is necessary
 for the performance of the contract to which you are a party, or to take action at your request, prior
 to the conclusion of the contract (art. 6, sec. 1, letter c GDPR) and is necessary for the purposes

Your personal data will be deleted 6 years after the end of the contract.

Your personal data will not be processed by automated means and will not be subject to profiling.
