INFORMATION OBLIGATIONS

In accordance with Article 13 (1) and (2) of the General Regulation on the Protection of Personal Data of 27 April 2016, I inform you that the controller of personal data is the Polish Air Navigation Services Agency, Wieżowa Street 8, 02-147 Warsaw. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of fulfilling the order for flexible entrusted space structures. The processing is necessary for the fulfilment of a legal obligation to which the controller is subject (art. 6, sec. 1, letter c GDPR), and this obligation results from the Regulation of the Minister of Infrastructure of 27 December 2018 on the structure of Polish airspace and the detailed conditions and manner of using that airspace and the Regulation of the Minister of Infrastructure of 18 January 2019 on flight restrictions for a period not exceeding 3 months.

The controller may have received your personal data in the scope of name, surname, address, telephone number, e-mail, company name directly from you, from the Civil Aviation Authority or the Head of Air Traffic Services of the Polish Armed Forces.

We will process your personal data for as long as you are on the list of entities authorized to procure airspace - once we are notified that you have been removed from that list, your personal data will be deleted.

Your personal data may be transferred to providers of IT systems and services with which PANSA cooperates, and to authorized entities upon documented request, e.g. the police. To the extent arising from the GDPR and with the limitations indicated therein, you have the right of access to the content of your data and the right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, the right to data portability and the right to object.

You have the right to lodge a complaint to the Personal Data Protection Office located at Stawki Street 2 in Warsaw. More information available at www.uodo.gov.pl.

Providing your personal data is obligatory and results directly from the law.
