

In accordance with Article 13 (1) and (2) of the General Regulation on the Protection of Personal Data of 27 April 2016, I inform you that the Controller of personal data is the Polish Air Navigation Services Agency, Wieżowa Street 8, 02-147 Warsaw. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of selling navigation services. This processing is necessary for the performance of the contract to which you are a party (GDPR Article 6 (1) (b) and is necessary to comply with the legal obligations imposed on the controller (GDPR Article 6 (1) (c) of the Act of 3 July 2002. Aviation Law and the Regulation of the Minister of Infrastructure of 20 August 2020 on the coordination and organization of flight schedules.

Your personal data will also be processed for the purpose of debt collection. This processing is necessary for the performance of the contract to which you are a party (GDPR Article 6 (1) (b) and results from the legitimate interest of the Administrator, which is to ensure the settlement of receivables (GDPR Article 6 paragraph 1 letter f).

Your personal data will be processed for the period provided for by law and the duration of the contract, and then for the time necessary to defend against possible claims.

Your personal data may be transferred to providers of IT systems and services, the EUROCONTROL Central Route Toll Office and may be made available to authorized entities upon documented request. Your personal data may also be transferred by the Administrator outside the European Economic Area, depending on the service you purchase. In addition, such a transfer may also be carried out m.in Microsoft as a Microsoft 365 service provider as part of the use of global cloud services. Microsoft carries out the transfer outside the EEA using security mechanisms based on standard contractual clauses in accordance with Article 46(2) of the GDPR.

To the extent arising from the GDPR and with the limitations indicated therein, you have the right of access to the content of your data and the right to rectification, erasure, restriction of processing, the right to data portability, the right to object. You also have the right to lodge a complaint to the Personal Data Protection Office located at Stawki Street 2 in Warsaw. More information available at [www.uodo.gov.pl](http://www.uodo.gov.pl).

Your personal data will not be processed in an automated manner and will not be subject to profiling.

Providing your personal data is a necessary condition for using the service, and the consequence of not providing them will be the inability to use it.
