

INFORMATION OBLIGATIONS

In accordance with Article 13 (1) and (2) of the General Regulation on the Protection of Personal Data of 27 April 2016, I inform you that the controller of personal data is the Polish Air Navigation Services Agency, Wieżowa Street 8, 02-147 Warsaw. Your personal data will be processed in order to register information about your intention to fly an unmanned aircraft, we will entrust in connection with the need to ensure safe, continuous, smooth and efficient air navigation in the Polish airspace.

The processing is necessary for the fulfillment of a legal obligation to which the controller is subject (Art. 6, sec. 1, letter c GDPR), and this obligation results from Guideline No. 7 of the President of the Civil Aviation Authority dated June 9, 2021 and the Act of April 16, 2020 on specific instruments of support in connection with the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus and also in connection with the performance of a task carried out in the public interest and in the exercise of public authority entrusted to the PAŻP (art. 6, sec. 1, letter e GDPR). We may also process your personal data for the purpose of carrying out communication with persons declaring their intention to fly an unmanned aircraft we entrust, and this processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller (art.6, sec. 1 letter f GDPR) recommending the provision of relevant information to persons declaring their intention to fly an unmanned aircraft we entrust.

We will process your personal data for no longer than 6 years after you delete your account in the application. The personal data that we will collect about you are: name and surname, residential address, activity data, pilot number assigned by the ULC, telephone number and information about your current location (based on GPS).

Your personal data may be transferred to providers of IT systems and services, including technology partners with whom PAŻP cooperates, the Civil Aviation Authority, and authorized entities upon documented request, such as the police. Within the scope of the GDPR and with the limitations indicated therein, you have the right to access the content of your data and the right to rectify, delete, limit processing, the right to data portability, the right to object.

You have the right to lodge a complaint to the Personal Data Protection Office located at Stawki Street 2 in Warsaw. More information available at www.uodo.gov.pl.

Providing your personal data is obligatory and results directly from the law. It is against the law to fly an unmanned aircraft without informing the PAŻP.
